



Below is a code of conduct for spectators provided by the Irish Rugby Football Union. These guidelines should be followed by spectators of **all** sports at Belfast Royal Academy. We thank you for your support.

- 1 Remember that although young people play organised rugby they are not 'miniature Internationals'.
- Be on your best behaviour and lead by example. Do not use profane language or harass referees, players or coaches.
- Applaud good play by the visiting team as well as your own.
- Show respect for your team's opponents. Without them there would not be a match.
- The use of violence in all forms should never be condoned.

- **6** Verbal abuse of players or referees cannot be accepted in any shape or form.
- 7 Players or referees are not fair targets for abuse.
- Encourage young players to play by the Laws of the Game.
- Spectators can contribute to the enjoyment of the event and all involved.
- Be proud of your team and the Game of Rugby.
